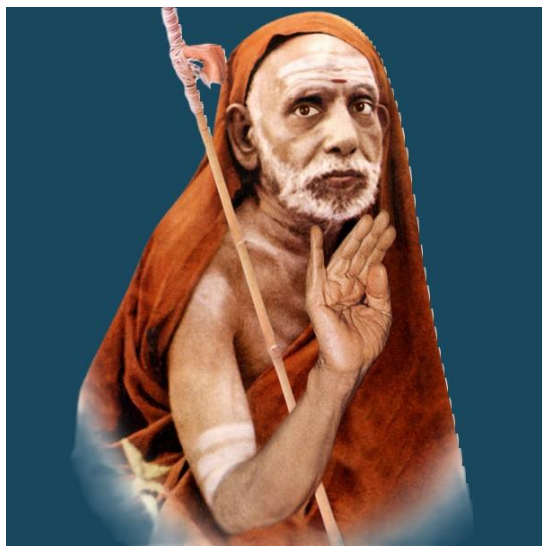

Chapter 4 Rama Nama and Maha Periyava



**Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswati VIII MahaSwamigal, known as
Maha Periyava of Kanchipuram, Tamilnadu, Bharat, India**

Jaya Jaya Shankara, Hara Hara Shankara.

Maha Periyava once mentioned in his discourse, that if you close your eyes and say, Rama, Rama, Rama, you will notice one person there smiling with happy tears and he is the Maha Purusha Sri Anjaneyar, Hanuman. He will be sitting right next to you protecting and motivating you like your Guru.

A lady was worried that she would be unable to have children. She prayed to Bhagwan to bless her with a child. The next day, a Yogi came and advised her to do Sri Rama Nama Japam and that she would have a talented blessed child. She completed One crore Rama Nama, and a son was born to her. Her son became a great sanyasi known as Sri Sadashiva Brahmendral. One of his famous works is “Pibare Rama Rasam” meaning

“Drink the nectar of Rama Nama”, where he explains the Tatva of Rama Nama in simple verses. Meditate on Rama, get the Ananda, immerse yourself in that Ananda then do Rama Japa or recite Ramayanam.

Sri Periyava advised everyone to Organize Sri Rama Nama writing events for the children and adults in temples and at home during Hindu festivals.

Sri Valmiki Bhagwan did Rama Japa before composing Sri Ramayana, Rama Nama is for all, irrespective of caste and creed; the Name of God was the only help for all problems during present-day Kali Yuga.

From Kruta-Yuga times there has been a decline in the powers of man. During Kruta -Yuga humans lived so long as their skeleton lasted. Even if their blood dried up and their flesh was destroyed, they survived until their bones collapsed. But people in the Kruta-Yuga age had much power of knowledge. They were called "Asti-Gata-Pranas".

In the Treta-Yuga age people were "Mams-Gata-Pranas", they lived as long as their flesh lasted and did not perish even when their blood dried up. They had a special capacity for performing sacrifices. In the Dvapara-Yuga, people were "Rudhira-Gata-Pranas" and lived until their red blood dried up. They were known especially for the pujas they performed.

We are now in the age of Kali-Yuga which is called "Annam-Gata-Pranas" meaning life will remain in our body so long as the food lasts. We get easily distracted by irrelevant things and have little focus to meditate and perform rituals or puja. But we can chant the names of the Gods, Sri Krishna, Sri Rama, and others. It is true that by repeating the Rama Nama and the names of our Gods we will be liberated to attain moksha.

Repeating the Divine Names of Gods helps everyone, even the worst sinner.

An old lady who was in a queue to get the blessings of Maha Periyava (Sri Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswati Swamigal of Kaanchi Kaamakoti Peetam) wore an auspicious look by wearing a white saree, with Rudraksha bead and crystal (Spatika) garland, with the forehead full of Vibhuthi, she prostrated at the feet of Maha Periyava.

Maha Periyava, looked at her and ordered his attendant to immediately bring 100 lemons and give them to her. The lady was puzzled because

usually, the devotees get one or two lemons but not 100 lemons. She looked at Maha Periyava with a question in her eyes.

"You are spending a lot of money buying lemons in the market to invoke the evil forces in those lemons. By performing black magic, you are eventually wrecking the lives of innocent people to earn money. Now you collect these 100 lemons, and it would be useful for your devilish work" Mahaperiyava said in a firm voice. She started crying wondering how he knew her profession and fell at the feet of Maha Periyava to forgive her and bless her.

Maha Periyava replied "You can utter those evil mantras into the ears of a cow and forget it once and for all. Never think of performing such black magic in your life. Spend the rest of your life by repeating Sri Rama Nama to be peaceful, this is your solution" He gave her Vibhudhi.

4.1 Rama Nama makes an Ordinary Person a Yogi

Sri Bodendra was the 58th pontiff of Kanchi Kamakoti Peedam. At his samadhi one can hear at night, a melodious voice, uttering Rama Nama and fading into silence. Sri Bodendra recited Rama Nama throughout his life.

Sri Bodhendra once went to a village called Thirukokarnam in Bharat, India to give a discourse about Rama Nama. He was initiating everyone in that village with Rama Nama. A daasi servant came to him and asked if she could also chant Rama Nama and if he would initiate her. Sri Bodhendral initiated her with Rama Nama without any hesitation. In those days sanyasis were not even allowed to speak to women and when he directly initiated a woman who was a servant, the villagers started speaking ill about him. After some days Sri Bodhendra left the village. The servant was chanting Rama Nama religiously and would chant throughout the day. Sri Bodhendra came back to that village after some time and came to know the woman had finished chanting crores of Rama Nama. The Servant came to have a darshan of Sri Bodhendra and after prostrating to him she left this world through Kabala Moksha in front of her guru like how a yogi leaves this world. The villagers were surprised to see this and realized their mistake not to judge poor people.

Kanchi Paramacharya said that one can hear the chanting of Rama nama in the Govindapuram Adhistanam of Sri Bodendra Saraswati.

4.2 Bhagawan Nama Cured the Plague in Arcot City.

Arcot city in Bharat, India was hit by plague once and there was no treatment during that time. The Nawab was also attacked by plague, and it so happened that Sri Bodhendral was there in Arcot. The people in the city went and told their problem to Sri Bodhendral, who then asked them to get together and chant Rama Nama. Once they did as advised everyone was cured and there was no trace of plague in the city. The Nawab then offered some land to His mutt and became His follower.

Maha Periyava did Rama Nama Japa in a bullock cart before becoming a sanyasi.

Rama Nama has the power of the entire Ramayanam in just two Akshara's words Rama Nama. So, doing Rama Japam gets all the benefits that one gets from doing Gayatri Japa.

In this age of Kali, there is no other means, except Rama Nama for Jiva's humans to attain liberation" says Sage Sanatkumara to Sage Narada.

Rama Nama is the only mantra that is called the "Taraka Mantra". It is the mantra that helps one to cross the cycles of birth and death.

Thyagaraja Brahman of Tiruvaiyaru in Tamilnadu, India, performed Rama Nama Japa for twenty-one years. Every day lakh and eight thousand 100,008 counts of Japa.

In the Vedic script Ramacharitamansa, it is mentioned that Rama Nama gave strength even to Sri Hanuman

In Guru Granth Sahib, the sacred book and current guru of Sikhism, the name of Rama is the second most used name for the formless God after the name Sri Hari.

Neem Karoli Baba encouraged the constant repetition of "Ram" to become closer to God, saying: "By taking the name of Ram, everything will be accomplished."

A popular mantra is Om Sri Ram Jai Ram Jai Jai Ram was popularized in western India by Samarth Ramdas.

"Ramanama Satya hai" (meaning, the name of Rama is the Truth) is a Hindi phrase commonly chanted by Hindus while carrying a dead body to be cremated.

Thyagaraja, a composer of Carnatic music, wrote Rama Nama in his compositions of Keerthana's.

Swami Ramdas attained nirvana through the constant repetition of "Om Sri Ram, Jai Ram Jai Jai Ram". He established Anand Ashram, where this mantra is sung continuously from morning till night.

In Sri Swamiji's words, 'Even if the whole sky were used as a paper and all the waters of the Universe were used as ink, it would just not suffice to pen down the glories of Rama Nama!'

4.3 Sages and Rama Nama

Rishi Manu shows that the Rama Nama has links to all the other mantras that ever existed.

In Syavana Smriti (Syavana is the name of a rishi), Syavana says that the Rama Nama is the essence of all the Vedas, Shastras, Itihasas, and Puranas.

Sage Vasishta meditated on the Rama Nama all the time.

4.4 Rama Nama and YOGA Connection

In the philosophy of Yoga, 'Ra' is considered the 'Mooladhara' (the point of origin of the power of Kundalini), and 'Ma' is the 'Sahasrara' (the destination). Hence, when the Rama Nama is chanted in the right tone and manner, the serpent power rises and hits the head or the 'kapala' Thus, by merely chanting the Rama Nama, one can become a Yogi.

4.5 The Bhagavan's (Gods) Favorite

The 'Sthala Purana' of Kasi says that the deity Kasi Viswanatha initiates the Rama Nama to everyone at the time of their death, in their right ear.

Bhagavan Sri Dhakshinamurthy observes silence because He doesn't want to waste any time without chanting the Rama Nama.

The Sun God chants the Rama Nama because he is proud that Sri Rama came from his dynasty.

Rama Nama is so powerful that by chanting it, one gets the benefit of invoking all the 33 crores of devatas as well.

4.6 Rama Nama is One Name for All Gods

Generally, people can be divided into two broad categories: the Shaivites, who worship Lord Shiva as the supreme, and the Vaishnavites, who worship Lord Vishnu and His forms as the Supreme Being. The most significant Mantra for any Vaishnavite is the 'Ashtakshari' (it contains eight letters in Sanskrit) mantra 'Om Namō Narayana'.

The Mantras for the Shaivites is the Panchakshari (5-lettered) mantra, 'Om Nama Shivaya'. Without the letter 'ra', 'Narayana' would read as 'Nayana' which means one without a way, without the letter, 'ma', 'Namasivaya' would read as 'Nasivaya' which means inauspicious.

So, the Jiva Akshara (life-giving letters) 'Ra' and 'Ma' of these two Mantras are combined to form the Rama Nama!

Anyone chanting this Divine Name thus worships both Shiva and Vishnu at the same time.

Sri Ramakrishna initiated Swami Vivekananda into 'Rama' Nama. It is the power of that Divine Name that made him establish this Universal Religion of Brotherhood called Hinduism all over the world.

Mahatma Gandhi, in his final lecture before independence, said, 'We have tried our level best. Now let us all chant the Divine Name together. Only that has the power to get us independence.' Not one of his prayers passed without Rama Nama Kirtan.

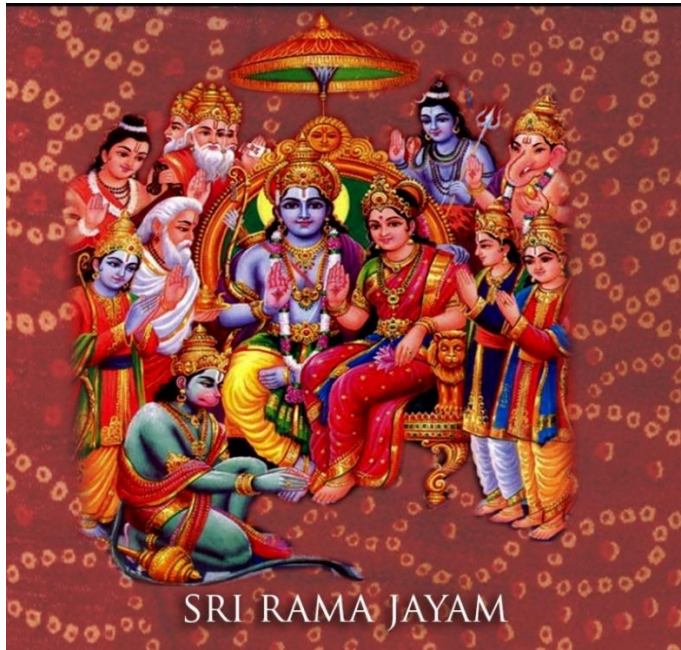
4.7 Ayodhya, Kanchipuram, and Kasi Ancient Divine Connection

King Dasaratha of Ayodhya did not have children and one night he had a dream that he should visit Kanchipuram to seek the blessings of Kamakshi amma to have children. Even today many childless couples visit Kanchipuram for her blessings to have children.

It was in Tretha --Yuga that King Dasaratha traveled from Ayodhya to Kanchipuram for the blessings of Kamakshi amma and only after her blessings, Sri Rama was born in Ayodhya. Kamakshi Amma powers were mentioned in Brahmanda Purana and the divine connection between

Kanchipuram and Ayodhya is mentioned in the 38-40th Chapters of Sri Lalithapakyanam and the Panchabhuta Stallams meaning 5 Elements of Nature (Earth, Water, Fire, Air, Space) which belong to Bhagavan Shiva. There is a temple for each element. It is mentioned that Ayodhya, Kanchipuram, and Kasi are called Prithivi Shetrams for attaining Moksham (salvation), Liberation from the cycle of births and deaths. Kanchi mut branches have been there in Ayodhya and Kasi for many years.

Chapter 5 Rama Nama Ramayanam



Nama Ramayanam is a short description or essence of the entire Ramayana in 108 Slokas, explaining the divine qualities of Sri Rama. This was written by Bhakta Ramadasu. Ramayana is originally divided into 7 parts called Kaandas namely Bala Kaanda, Aranya Kaanda, Kishkinda Kaanda, Sundara Kaanda, Yuddha Kaanda, and Uttara Kaanda. Nama Ramayanam is also divided into 7 parts with the same names, and it is easy to recite, listen, and learn quickly. It is said that reciting Nama Ramayanam gives the same result as reading the entire Ramayanam. As said in the above extract, she is unmatched in her beauty throughout her existence. She is the one who gives the word “beauty” Its meaning.

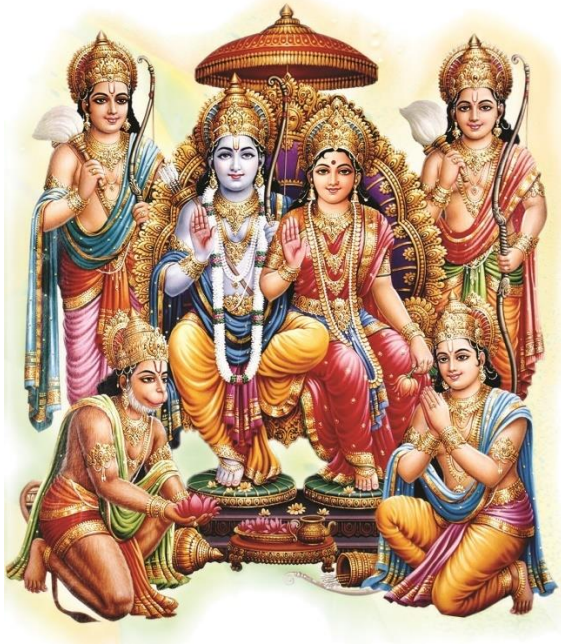

She prays to Vasundhara, another name of Mother Earth, to come and take her. The earth splits and a golden Throne rises from the earth. Sita goes and sits on the throne and the earth goes down, never to see Sita again. Sita is an avatar of Lakshmi on earth and the wife of Sri Rama. Sita is Lakshmi wife of Sri Vishnu in Vaikuntam. Avatars do not die they disappear to the origin from where they came and in this case, Sita joined Sri Vishnu in Vaikuntam

Sita who is also an avatar of Lakshmi, knew that Sri Rama's Avatar had to come to an end since Rama was born as a human, and he could not escape the cycle of birth and death. 10.1 Why did One Sage Come to meet Sri Rama?

One day a sage Sri Kala Deva (Kala means Time) came to meet Sri Rama and said that nobody should enter the room when they are discussing a serious topic of utmost importance. Sri Rama requested Sri Lakshmana to guard the door of the room.

10.2 Sri Lakshmana Final Days

Sage Sri Durvasa, who is known to be short-tempered came and demanded he be allowed inside to meet Sri Rama. Lakshmana told him he had orders not to allow anyone inside. Durvasula threatened Lakshmana that he would curse that Lakshmana would die or entire Ayodhya citizens would die if he was not allowed inside the room. Lakshmana told him that he would rather die than break his word to Sri Rama and to save the citizens of Ayodhya. Sage Durvasu left angrily. Lakshman realized that this event was the play of time for him to disappear from earth. He readily agreed to the play of Kala (Time). Lakshmana goes to the nearby Sarayu River in Ayodhya and walks into the river and disappears marking the end of Sri Lakshmana who goes to Vaikuntam heaven.

10.3 What is Sage Kala Devas's Secret Message to Sri Rama?

Sage Kala Deva informs Sri Rama that his avatar of Sri Vishnu, born as Sri Rama must end. He told Rama that his purpose to restore dharma on the earth is complete and it is time to return to join Sri Vishnu.

10.4 When did Sri Rama Know About his Final Day?

Sri Rama comes to know about what Lakshmana did and decides it is time to end his avatar and return to Vaikuntam, heaven. He hands over all his responsibilities to his sons. Sri Rama realizes that being born as a human; he needs to face death too like all humans.

Sri Vishnu incarnated in different forms to preserve the universe and to restore "Peace and Dharma" in the four yugas (era or cycle)

Satya Yuga (the avatars were Matsya, Kurma, Varaha, Narasimha),

Treta Yuga (the avatars were Vamana, Parasuram, and Sri Rama),

Dwapara Yuga (Avatars were Balarama, and Sri Krishna) and

Kali Yuga (the avatar to be born is Kalki avatar)

1. Satya Yuga $4 \times 432000 \text{ years} = 1,728,000 \text{ Years}$
2. Treta Yuga $3 \times 432000 \text{ years} = 1,296,000 \text{ Years}$
3. Dvapara Yuga $2 \times 432000 \text{ years} = 864,000 \text{ Years}$
4. Kali Yuga $1 \times 432000 \text{ years} = 432,000 \text{ Years}$

10.6 We are in Kali Yuga now Year 2024

Kali Yuga lasts for 432,000 Years which is equivalent to 1200 God or Divine Years. Kali Yuga began when Sri Krishna died 5125 Years ago, and has 426,875 Years left as of 2024 CE. Kali Yuga will end in the Year 428,899 CE.

This is one of the time-tested easiest ways of Bhakthi Yoga. A path to reach God through your devotion. These are some ways of doing Bhakti Yoga.

Devotees chose their favorite deity or God name to repeatedly chant the name vocally or in mind anytime, anywhere. Devotees can form a group and do Sankeerthanam or sing together in the name of God. This is also called Satsangh

Bhajans are one way of singing, the glory of God to focus on God.

Nama Japa, Sankeerthanam, and Bhajans all result only in one thing, helping devotees identify themselves with God. We can also call this group meditation through singing.

In ancient times, Gurus knew it was very difficult to meditate on God because we get easily distracted for various reasons, hence they advised everyone to meet in groups at temples and homes to sing bhajans.

Even in today's time, Nama Japa is the easiest way to meditate on God. Nama Japa is the simplest and easiest way to see the God in us and everything surrounding us.

13.2 Sri Adi Sankaracharya

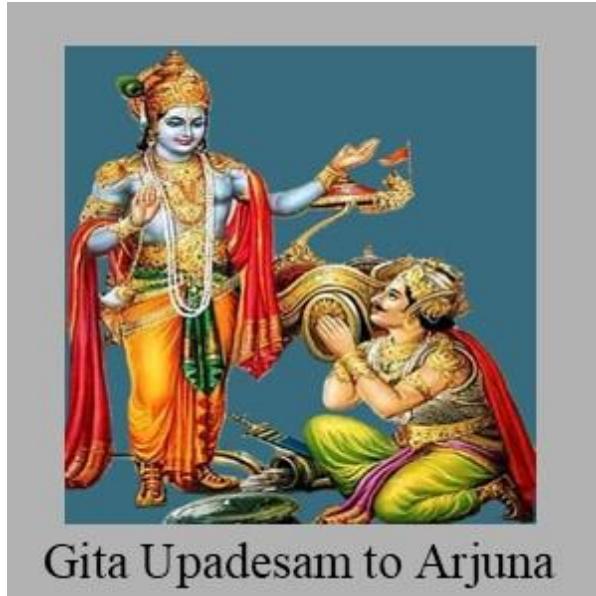

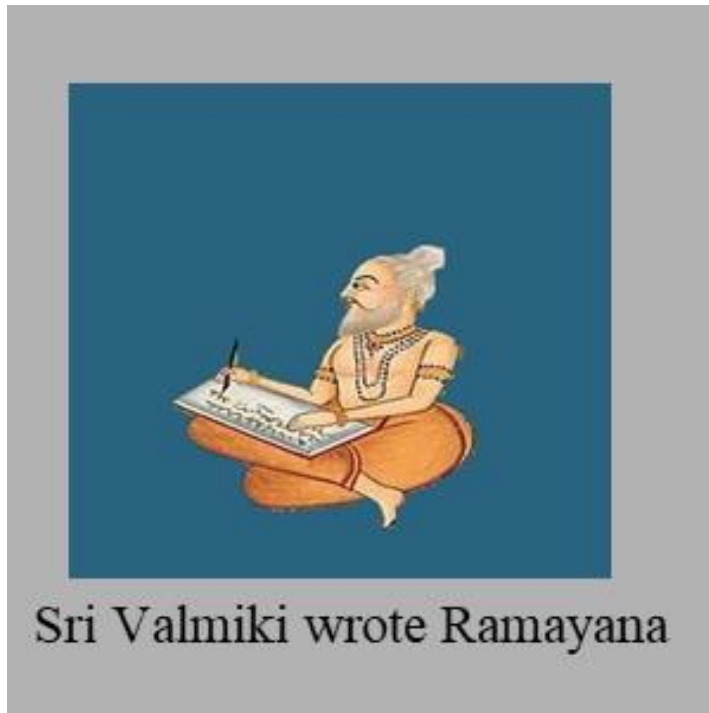

The name **Ra-Ma** is a combination of Maheshwa**RA-MA**heshwari denoting one Almighty, who is ArdhanarIshvara who is the single entity of Shiva (Purusha) and Shakthi (Parvati), one who pervades everything

Even breathing of the living beings signifies **Ra-Ma**.

We can become closer to God, Rama by repeating his name "Rama" and by repeating the name "Rama" we can accomplish everything in life

14.5 Personal Ego Vanishes during Rama Nama Japa.

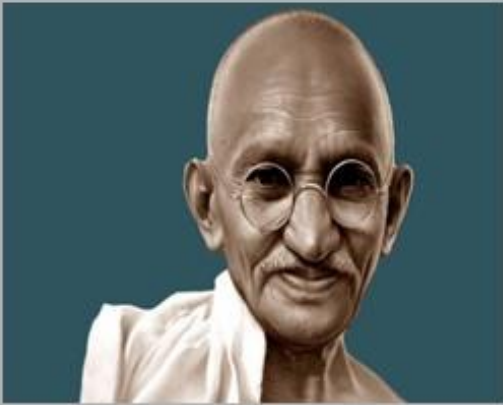

There are many people, who make a wish and start and soon find their wish coming true, but then it is important not to stop writing once your wish is fulfilled

Sri Rama Jayam or Jai Sri Ram are the powerful 3 words that are written, on the Hindu wedding invitation, or prayed in the mind before starting anything of importance in India.

Rama Koti Likhita Japa is writing Sri Rama Jayam or Jai Sri Ram daily. It is like meditating on Sri Rama and will help focus on life and bring inner peace leading to success.

Chapter 17 FAQs On Writing Sri Rama Jayam

17.1 What Color Pen should We Write?

Write with a pen with ink color **black** or **blue** or any color except **RED**.

Do not type or use computers to write Sri Rama Jayam

Sri Rama Jayam-Jai Sri Ram must be written only by hand because the movement of the hand as you write the words helps you focus and experience the power of the words for your wishes to come true.

Sri Rama Jayam -Jai Sri Ram means Victory to Sri Rama which will also result in victory for you to fulfill your wishes. We must think of Sri Rama while writing it and **NOT** write while watching a TV show.

You can choose what you like best from the following:

Sri Rama Jayam or Jai Sri Ram or Rama or SitaRam or Ram but the most ideal is to Sri Rama Jayam or Jai Sri Ram only because it matches the meaning of the words, Victory to Sri Rama

17.2 Who Can Write?

Both men and women can write Sri Rama Jayam. People of all ages can write. Children both Boys and Girls can start writing daily just 5 times from the age of 9 years. Ladies, please **DO NOT** write during your periods.

17.3 In What Language Can We Write?

You can write in any language, English, Telugu, Tamil, Hindi, or any Indian language. You can write in any foreign language provided you believe in this concept. Many Write in their mother tongue. Use Google Translator to translate from English to your language if you do not know how to write in your language. Given below are a few examples in Indian languages

17.6 What Do We Wear While Writing?

You can wear any dress in which you are comfortable.

17.7 Should we take a bath before writing Sri Rama Jayam?

It is advisable to take a bath before writing only to help you focus on writing with a fresh mind.

17.8 Can We Eat Non-Vegitarian or Drink Alcohol While Writing?

Good Question. You should not drink any alcohol or eat non-vegetarian before writing Sri Rama Jayam. Writing Sri Rama Jayam is like visiting the temple. What would you do in real life? Please do the same. You go to the temple and then perhaps eat non-veg or after that you drink alcohol.

Imagine you writing in front of a real Sri Rama Bhagavan. How dedicated you will be. Do the same at other times as well.

17.9 What Day or Time Do We Write?

You can write on any day of the week and any time of the day. Please ensure your body is clean, and you have your shower or bath. Your mind is clean, and you are thinking of only Sri Rama when you write, that is the main objective of writing Sri Rama Jayam-Jai Sri Ram.

17.10 Can I Watch TV and Write?

No. Do not watch TV and write just for the sake of writing it. **It is of no use.**

17.11 Can I give this task of writing to somebody else on my behalf?

A software engineer once wrote to me that he gave this work of writing,

to a poor person and paid him to write on his behalf. He thought he was helping the poor person. I replied to him that only the person who writes gets the benefits of writing and not him. We should not hand over this work to someone else. This is not like offshoring your official work. You promised Sri Rama that you would write and hence only you should write.

17.12 How Many Times Should We Write Each Time or Day?

Start with writing 5 words a day "Sri Rama Jayam" or Jai Sri Ram since we have 5 elements of the earth to be in sync with the universe. There is no stipulation that you must write x number of times each time or day. You can write multiples of 5 or write 108 per day since 108 is a magical divine number in Hinduism.

Some write 108 times a day to complete writing 1 crore words faster. This is the beauty of Hinduism. You have the freedom to do what you like best. Some people write for 21 days for their wish to come true. If you must take a break or are unable to write, do not feel bad thinking you may be punished by God. **God will not punish you.** You can restart writing whenever you can. Many miracles have happened to many during the first 21 days which motivated them to write more, till they completed 1 crore times. Over 1000 miracles have happened to me.

17.13 Goal to Write 1 Crore Sri Rama Jayam or Jai Sri Ram

Suppose your goal is to write 1 crore (100,000,00) Sri Rama Jayam or Jai Sri Ram in your lifetime. You can also set your own goals like writing 1008,10,008, 100,008, and giving them to your local temple.

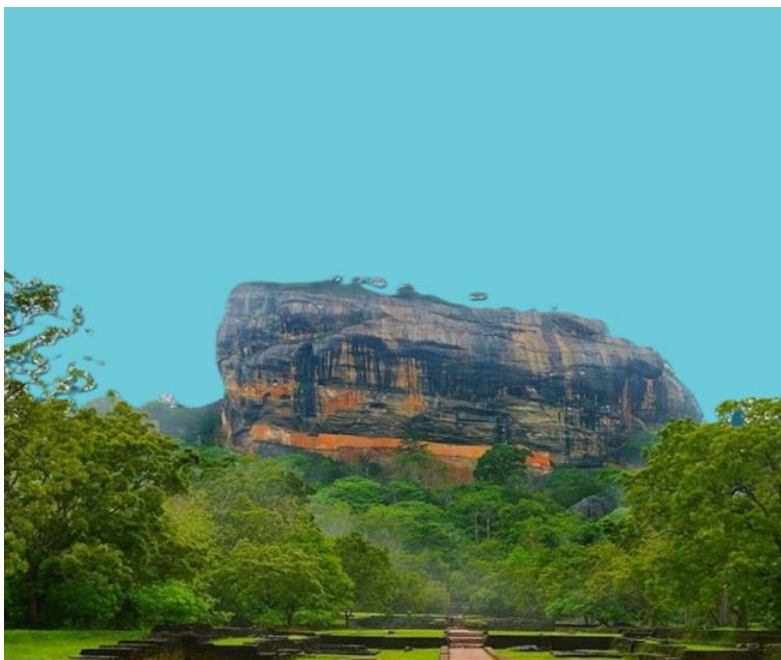
